Individual Consideration

ITEM 1. **Discussion/Action** – Consider approval of a request for an extended leave of absence to allow the Police Chief to attend the National FBI Academy in Quantico, VA., beginning April 2011.

The Mayor reminded the Council that this item had been on the agenda before and the only new information was an attached letter from Chief Moon offering to forfeit 2 weeks of his accrued vacation time in consideration of the Council allowing him to attend the FBI Academy training. The City Administrator pointed out that it is not actually a request for a leave of absence but instead it is a request to attend training.

Councilman Richard Dormier made a motion to accept the Chief's offer to forfeit 2 weeks accrued vacation and approve his leave request. Councilman Doug Hunt seconded the motion. The City Administrator explained that the Chief would not actually *forfeit* his vacation but in reality, he will put in to use 2 weeks of his accrued vacation time during the training period.
