- I. Mr. Stephen Fiedler, one of the street closure petitioners, spoke in favor of the closure and asked that the city take financial responsibility for the survey.


Mayor Dormier asked those wishing to speak against the closure and abandonment of a portion of Water Street to please step to the podium.
