

**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-25**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OVILLA, TEXAS, AMENDING THE 2021 - 2022 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET; PROVIDING REVISED SALARIES FOR THE POSITIONS OF CITY SECRETARY AND CITY ACCOUNTANT; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING A SEVERANCE CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR IMMEDIATE EFFECT; AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION.**

WHEREAS, on September 13, 2021, the City Council of the City of Ovilla approved the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget by adopting Ordinance No. 2021-17, after notice and public hearing as required by law; and

WHEREAS, the city manager has recommended to the City Council that the budgeted salaries for the positions of city secretary and city accountant be amended and increased in the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget; and

WHEREAS, City Council agrees with the recommendation of the city manager and finds and determines that the 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget should be amended to provide increased salaries for the positions of city secretary and city accountant as set forth herein.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVILLA, TEXAS, THAT:**

**SECTION 1.        AMENDMENT OF 2021-2022 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET**

The 2021-2022 Fiscal Year Budget for the City of Ovilla is amended in part as follows:

City Secretary	\$70,000	\$75,000
City Accountant	\$46,000	\$50,000

**SECTION 2.        SAVINGS CLAUSE**

In the event any other Ordinance of the City of Ovilla, Texas, heretofore enacted is found to conflict with the provisions of the Ordinance, this Ordinance shall prevail.

**SECTION 3. SEVERANCE CLAUSE**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court or competent jurisdiction, such shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE**

Because of the nature of interest and safeguard sought to be protected by this Ordinance and in the interest of the citizens of the City of Ovilla, Texas, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately after passage, approval and publication, as required by law.

**SECTION 5. PUBLICATION**

The City Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to cause publication of the descriptive caption and penalty clause hereof as an alternative method of publication provided by law.


